


WHAT'S AT STAKE FOR ACCESS TO MEDICATION ABORTION CARE?


Attorneys general (AG) in ID, KS, and MO have filed a new lawsuit (MO v FDA) in front of Judge Kacsmaryk arguing that FDA must rollback the updates it made to how mifepristone, a safe and effective medication used in early abortion and pregnancy loss, can be prescribed and dispensed. The FDA should set the standard for safe and effective access to medications, not state AGs.



Mifepristone has **25 years** of data and real-world evidence of safety.



Medication abortion accounts for more than half of all abortions in the U.S. and telehealth accounts for 20% of all abortions.
