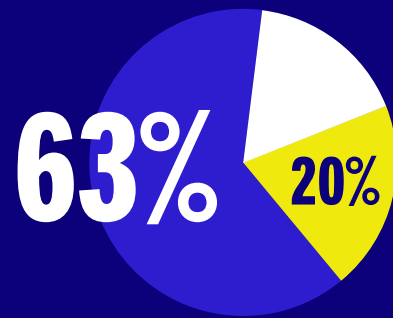


WHAT'S AT STAKE FOR ACCESS TO MEDICATION ABORTION CARE?

Attorneys general (AG) in ID, KS, and MO have filed a new lawsuit (*MO v FDA*) in front of Judge Kacsmaryk arguing that FDA must rollback the updates it made to how mifepristone, a safe and effective medication used in early abortion and pregnancy loss, can be prescribed and dispensed. **The FDA should set the standard for safe and effective access to medications, not state AGs.**



Mifepristone has **25 years** of data and real-world evidence of safety.



Medication abortion accounts for **more than half** of all abortions in the U.S. and telehealth accounts for 20% of all abortions.
